Role Purpose:

The role of Draftsman – Land Surveys is to create visual technical survey plans to support the surveyor and NCDC in plans suitable to addressing land related matters such as land grants, leases and licenses, the reservation and allocation of State and Customary land, and/or determination of roads, water, electrical services, both current and future.

- a) Technical drawing development prepares accurate and detailed survey drawings, plans and maps using industry-standard drafting software and tools
- b) Effective collaboration communicates with the surveyor, engineers and other team members to ensure seamless and expedient preparation of survey drawings

Experience & Qualification:

1. Qualifications

- Min. diploma in drafting, surveying &/or land studies.
- Computer training and formal certification in CAD, highly desirable.
- Membership with the Association of Surveyors of PNG is highly desirable.

2. Work Experience

- Minimum of two (2) years experience in a drafting capacity, preferably in lands planning
- Minimum of two (2) years experience with using CAD design software.

3. Skills

• Strong written, numeracy and computer and writing skills to produce quality and detailed reports and plans.

- Self-driven and motivated, able to work with minimal supervision and communicate effectively to deliver outcomes.
- A drive for continuous improvement towards new effective and efficient processes.
- Ability to meet demands and deadlines, work under high pressure, maintain confidentiality, be organized, self-disciplined, motivated, honest and reliable.
- Must be dedicated to the advancement of NCDC, its goals and vision for Port Moresby.

4. Knowledge

- Strong knowledge of the theory, principles and practices of surveying
- Knowledge of cartography, site planning and graphic design principles and methods
- Knowledge of the Acts and Regulations relevant to surveying, including the PNG Survey Act
- National Capital District Commission Act (2001)
